You may have heard it said that Jesus talked about money more than any other topic. Jesus did talk a lot about money – but it usually wasn't to talk about money. Jesus talked about money mostly to make a larger point about life and salvation.

Throughout the Gospels, Jesus used money as a tool to reveal our true allegiances. Our bank statement can tell the truth about what's really important to us. We invest our money and our time in what we value most. Jesus hammers this home in the Sermon on the Mount when He tells us: "Do not store up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moths and vermin destroy, and where thieves break in and steal. But store up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where moths and vermin do not destroy, and where thieves do not break in and steal. For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also." (Matthew 6:19-21)

His point is that if we truly believe life is eternal, we won't invest all of our time and finances into possessions and entertainments that will simply perish. Instead, we will pour our energy and resources into the with our relationship with Jesus that will resonate throughout eternity.


As Jesus puts it, money frequently operates as a rival 'god' who challenges our allegiance to the only true God (Matthew 6:24). The truth is that the 'god' that money invites us to worship is really ourselves as we indulge in our own comfort and pleasure.

God created everything and everything ultimately belongs to Him. We as His children are stewards (or managers) of God's resources, which includes our money. Stewardship isn't just an aspect of the Christian life; it is the whole of the Christian life. Stewardship is more than money, it is our time and talents as well. To be honest, God is not actually interested in our money. He can make all of the wealth He could every want or need. God is interested in our hearts. And how we manage what God has entrusted to us reveals where our heart is.

For many people, the struggle to be aligned with God's grace is played out in the realm of our finances. It's where the real battle happens for so many. Martin Luther is quoted as saying, "There are three conversions necessary: the conversion of the heart, the conversion of the mind, and the conversion of the purse."

Jesus talks about money because when we get our relationship with money squared away, it frees us up in our relationship with Him. Build treasure in heaven, not on earth.






The Men's Group meets every Saturday morning at 7:00am. All men are invited to join us for a time of study and fellowship.
